U.S. Census Bureau

Local Employment Dynamics (LED)

- Partnership between Census Bureau (LEHD) and State agencies
- Access to administrative records
 - Unemployment Insurance (UI) Wage Records
 - Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW)
- Combine with other data sources
- Frame of Jobs, Firms, and Workers

LEHD Data Products

- Quarterly Workforce Indicators (QWI)
 - 30 job-based indicators
 - State, county, metropolitan/micropolitan areas
 - Age, ownership, race, ethnicity, education, industry, firm age, firm size breaks
- LEHD Origin-Destination Employment Statistics (LODES)
 - Home-Work relationships
 - Census blocks based
 - Age, earnings, industry, race, ethnicity, education breaks
- Job-to-Job Flows (in development)
- AWI (in development)

 - QWI Online
 - Industry Focus
- LODES
 - OnTheMap
 - OnTheMap for Emergency Management

OnTheMap

- Census Block-based Data Origin-Destination Data (employment and residential locations – LODES)
- Free, Public, Web Application
- Map-based User Interface
- 6 Different Analyses
- Map, Chart, and Table Outputs
- Import/Export Shapefiles & KMLs

Latest Updates

- Addition of 2011 Data
 - 50 States/Territories including DC
 - Federal Workers
 - OD by Age, Earnings, Industry Group
 - AC by Age, Earnings, Industry Sector, Race, Ethnicity, Education, Sex...
- Firm Age and Firm Size as New Variables
 - Beta. Only for 2011, All Private Jobs, Work locations.
 - National Concepts
